







Unlocking Innovation and Entrepreneurship

2-Day workshop on Unlocking Innovation and Entrepreneurship was held during the Startup Fest 2023. This workshop was to educate students about the two crucial factors of startups i.e. Design Thinking and Lean Canvas Model. This was a unique blend of both knowledge sessions and group activities which aimed to give the participants the correct understanding of need of a startup in a society as well as how to start a startup. Mr. Manas Kumar Samantaray & Mr. Bibhu P Bahalia were mentor for the occasion.



Total 26 groups participated in this workshop and in the end, their Idea Canvases and Lean Canvases were evaluated for the "Best Idea Unlocker" competition. The Winning Group received a cash prize of INR 5,000/- whereas the Runners Up Group received INR 2,500/-.

Innovate Odisha

Innovate Odisha was a 24-hour long non-stop hackathon, organized by AIC-Nalanda and Karkhana Makerspace, in collaboration with Atal Innovation Mission and Startup Odisha. For this hackathon 200 applications were received from 18 colleges across Odisha on Applied Robotics, IoT, Cloud & AI, Metaverse & Web 3.0 and Future Mobility themes. 80 participants from 20 selected groups were part of the main hackathon which was held on 19th and 20th February 2023 at AIC-Nalanda premises. Representatives from Startups, Communities and Govt. Bodies were part of this mega hackathon.

Inauguration Ceremony witnessed the presence of our Chief Guest, Dr. Tapan Kumar Chand, President, Vedanta Aluminium & DG, AIC-Nalanda, our Guest of Honor, Mr. Shubhajit Jagdev, Founder & CEO, EduSkills, Mr. Siddharth Bhatter, Founder & CEO, Karkhana Makerspace, Mr. Devjyoti Mohanty, CEO, AIC-Nalanda and Mr. Manas Kumar Samantray, Program Manager, AIC-Nalanda.

Dr. Chintan Vaishnav, Mission Director, Atal Innovation Mission, had a recorded video message for the participants of Innovate Odisha which was showcased during the official launch.









On the completion of 24 hours, the final presentation round kicked off. 20 teams pitched and showcased their products before the jury panel and the evaluation was based on the scale of their innovation & its revenue generation model.



Innovate Odisha came to an end with the Valedictory Ceremony where Dr Omkar Rai, Executive Chairman, Startup Odisha presided as the Chief Guest. Dr. Rai congratulated the Winners, Top Performers and encouraged the participants to be entrepreneurs in the future. He also added that the ecosystem of Odisha is growing, and these young innovators are the new future of Odisha.



Team "The Four Musketeers" were declared the Winners and were awarded a Cash Prize of Rs. 25,000/- whereas Team "Hawk-AI", "Deep Divers" & "Codex" were able to grab "Runners Up", "Best Business Idea" and "Best Innovative Idea" position and were awarded with Rs. 15,000/-, Rs. 5,000/- & Rs. 5,000/- respectively.


Ideanest 3.0 (Student Edition)






