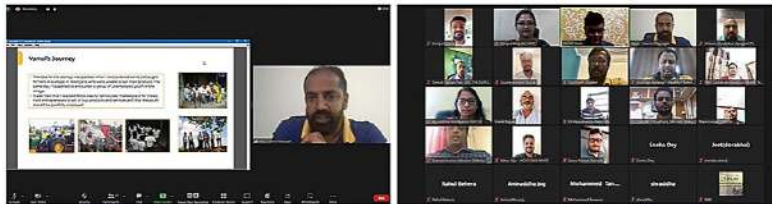


## Sanvriddhi 2.0 STARTUP ACCELERATION PROGRAM

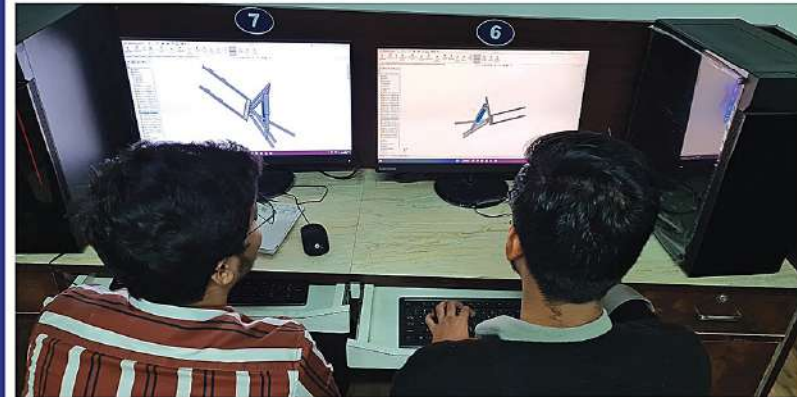

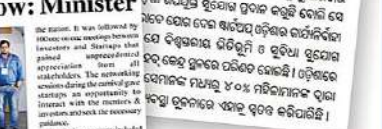
## Odisha Right Place for Startups to Grow: Minister
